THE GOAL

The Active SWV website serves as a hub for resources for a healthier West Virginia. The main goal of the Active SWV website is to convey the program's information in the most easy-to-understand way. The organization has also hosted numerous events throughout the region and looked to highlight that work on the site.



THE APPROACH

One of the struggles with the organization's old site was information being buried underneath pages upon pages - and employees even found it challenging to find certain information. The site itself was also outdated in both content and design. One of the biggest structural changes was the implementation of an integrated Google Calendar that lists all of the events in the upcoming months.



THE LOOK

Active SWV is known for their bright, neon green color palette. The color scheme for their old site primarily used dark blue shades and it did not resonate with the organization's color palette, logo, and overall brand. The JJN Multimedia web team utilized dark green and orange as headings, with light green accents throughout the page.
